



Diabetic Supplies and Equipment

Did you know that you can receive most of your diabetic supplies from the same pharmacy that is filling your prescriptions?

Retail or Mail Order Pharmacy

The following diabetic supplies can be dispensed at your retail or mail order pharmacy with a prescription from your physician:

Traditional Blood Glucose Supplies

- Blood glucose meters such as Abbott Freestyle and LifeScan OneTouch
- Blood glucose test strips
- Blood glucose lancets

Continuous Blood Glucose Supplies

- Freestyle Libre Device and Sensor
- Dexcom G6/G7 Device, Sensor, and Transmitter

Other Diabetic Supplies

- Insulin Syringes
- Glucose Tablets
- Alcohol Swabs

Omnipod® 5

- The Omnipod® 5 must be dispensed at the Pharmacy. It cannot be obtained at a Durable Medical Equipment provider.

Durable Medical Equipment (DME) Provider

There are several types of diabetic supplies and equipment available through one of our participating DME providers. These include:

Traditional and Continuous Glucose Supplies:

Please note: these supplies may be obtained at a DME provider; however, you can also fill these types of supplies, if available, at your local retail pharmacy.

To obtain any of the diabetic supplies, contact one of our DME providers on the back of this flyer. A prescription from your physician is required. Your member cost share will follow the diabetic supply and diabetic equipment benefit.
